GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Conner Christian Scholarship Foundation was established to enable students to obtain an elementary or secondary education at Christian schools. The scholarship may pay either full or partial tuition for the entire academic year.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The student must show financial need and must have an average grade point of C+ (2.5 GPA) or better during his or her previous academic career. If the student is applying for scholarship beginning in grade one, no initial grade point average is required. Once a student has met the initial qualifications for the scholarship, funding for future tuition will continue as the student maintains the minimum grade point average, continues education in a Christian School, and can show financial need for each succeeding year. The student must provide school transcripts to the Foundation following each academic year.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

An application may be obtained from you school administrator, guidance counselor, or you may apply directly to the Foundation. In addition to basic information, you will be asked to provide documentation of financial need, including signed copies of selected pages of your latest federal income tax return, as well as, information about any other income you receive.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

To qualify for educational assistance beginning in the fall semester, the application should be submitted by August 15th.
